STURTEVANT - Robert Torres, 67, passed away at his residence surrounded by his loved ones on Monday, January 23, 2012, after a courageous three year battle with pancreatic cancer.

Robert was a veteran of the United States Army and was proud to serve during the Vietnam War. He had a passion for truck driving. He owned and operated BSA Trucking and later drove for numerous companies including J.I. Case Corporate Fleet and Roadway. He retired from the Teamsters Local 200.
