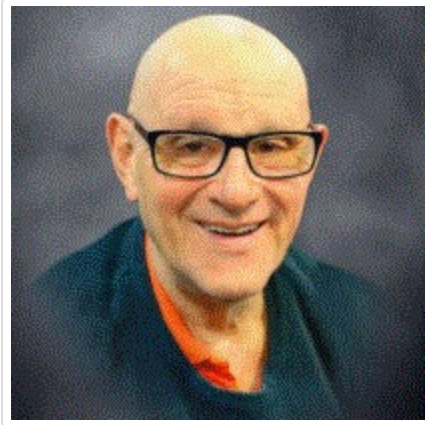




Thomas Clyde Bertling

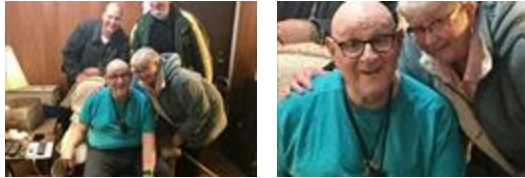
